Snake Bite

The Neglected Tropical Disease

WHO reinstated snake-bite envenoming to its category A neglected tropical diseases (NTDs) list. Every year, more than 95 000 people die from snake bites, and a further 300 000 survive but with permanent disabilities. Most snake bite victims live in the world's poorest communities, with agricultural workers, children, and rural dwellers most at risk. About half of documented deaths from snake bites are in India

Most of the fatalities are due to the victim not reaching the hospital when definite treatment can be administered. It continues to adopt harmful first aid practices such as tourniquets, cutting and suction, etc. Studies reveal that primary care doctors do not treat snakebite patients mainly due to lack of confidence.


